

Come feel the heat at a new group exhibition featuring a variety of work in "hot" hues by gallery artists: Alfonso Fratteggiani Bianchi, Tony DeLap, Frederick Hammersley, Scot Heywood, William Metcalf, Jeremy Thomas, Eric Tillinghast, Anne Truitt, and Susan York. Red, black, brilliant yellow, these works not only rivet the eye but create an atmosphere of sophistication with their elegance.


Tony DeLap creates three-dimensional paintings of saturated color and complex form. Alfonso Bianchi works in pure powdered pigment applied directly to Italian limestone with his hand. Anne Truitt and Frederick Hammersley, as early pioneers in color field, provide a historical reference to the show. Scot Heywood, an exciting new addition to Charlotte Jackson Fine Art, has explored the relationships between color, space, and geometry since the mid 70's. William Metcalf's sleek sculptural paintings are constructed from translucent polyester fabric painted with acrylics. Jeremy Thomas's inflated sheet metal sculpture, a powdercoated steel arc by Eric Tillinghast, and Susan York's lustrous solid graphite cubes round out the mix.

This month Charlotte Jackson Fine Art offers an exhibition that will make you want to put on your best black and hit the town. An excellent combination of the very latest in contemporary art executed with classic style.





ALFONSO FRATTEGGIANI BIANCHI #217 Rojo Arancio, Pigment on limestone, 12" x 11", AFB006




FREDERICK HAMMERSLEY Mutual Fund, #1, 1972 Oil on linen, 44" x 44", FH0081




JEREMY THOMAS Case Red, 2006 Forged mild steel and powder coat, 50" x 40" x 36", JT0046






SUSAN YORK Graphite Square No. 3, 2005 Solid graphite, 5" x 5" x 1 ½", SY0016


