Mala Breuer, Lawrence Fodor, Florence Pierce




Friends and Family features work by artists, including Florence Pierce and Mala Breuer, who have been a part of Charlotte Jackson Fine Art since its very beginning, as well as work by long-time friend of the gallery, artist Lawrence Fodor. Fodor's epic installation, Holding Light 4, provided the inspiration for the exhibition. A collection of 315 individual 7 x 7 inch watercolors on archival recycled paper mounted on maple wood, the pieces are arranged to shift along the chromatic scale from all directions (horizontally, vertically and diagonally). The corner pieces provide the key color origins, with the remaining pieces formulated into specific gradations. The very center piece is a perfect mix of the four colors. In counterpoint to this chromatic pattern each individual watercolor is a unique, intuitive expression. Fodor's works strike up a strong dialogue with a selection of Mala Breuer's small early canvases. These works highlight her distinctive "mark making", finding roots in her early experience as a student of Clyfford Still. Weaving in and out of this dialogue are the strong punctuation marks of Florence Pierce's resin reliefs. Her pristine works both shift in color and hold light as the viewer moves around them. The overall effect of Friends and Family is one of harmonious balance, careful precision, and fascination with the nature and experience of light.


















